










# Summer Book Selections by Grade

# A Summer's Worth of Lesson Plans!

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## Sample Lesson Plan Breakdown for a 22-day Summer School Program:

### Days 1–3: Introductory Lessons

The first three days of the 22-day instruction period will be reserved for setting expectations and giving students an overview of the program.

### Days 4–20: Book 1 + Book 2 Lesson Plans

After completing the Introductory Lessons, teachers can choose one of two ways to teach the emotional workout ([see options 1 and 2 below](#)).

### Days 21–22: Culminating Lessons

After completing the book lessons, teachers will lead students in activities that will prompt them to reflect on and share what they have learned during the summer.

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### Option 1: Done-for-you Lesson Plans

Done-for-you lesson plans will challenge students to think about the book's lesson through different academic lenses, such as math, science, health, etc. In these lesson plans, teachers will find discussion prompts and suggested pacing for each part of the lesson. ### Option 2: Teacher's Choice

Option 2 allows teachers to flex their creative muscles in how they execute lessons in their classrooms. Teachers will use the Making Connections activities listed for each of their assigned books to inspire their own lesson plans. Teachers will have the autonomy to pace their own lessons.
